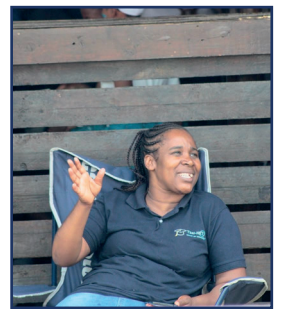

MESSAGE FROM PREFECTS

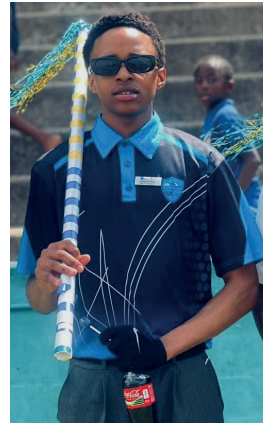
Fellow Kemptonians,
